## **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. To be in proper uniform with CPR and gloves in fanny pack at all times. your pool.
- 2. To develop and implement the program that has been developed.
- 3. To do a weekly schedule for staff that insures there is sufficient coverage at all times.
- 4. To develop and implement the swim lessons, swim team, and daily activities at your pool.
- 5. To ensure safety and well being of all staff and participants at your facility.
- 6. To make sure all equipment at your pool is in working order.
- 7. To take daily attendance of all staff and participants at your pool.
- 8. To meet with the Water Coordinator, the Assistant Water Coordinator, and your staff on a daily basis.
- 9. To make sure the facility is clean, safe, and clear of debris before and during your work day.
- 10. To do chemical tests as required and record.
- 11. To make sure all accident reports are completed properly by your staff before turning them over to the Water Coordinator or the Assistant Water Coordinator.
- 12. To fill-out and turn in all attendance and time sheets on a weekly basis.
- 13. To conduct two staff and one program evaluation.
- 14. To be the liaison between the staff and the parents.
- 15. Oversee covid protocols as determined by the Department, Board of Health and state Health Department.
- 16. To perform all other duties as needed.
