

Lowell Recreation Parent Code of Conduct

Lowell Recreation provides free and low cost programming to all children who register for activities. The Office requires parents to follow a minimum standard of appropriate behavior in order to maintain the safety and integrity of the program. Below is a list of basic requirements for parents to follow.

- 1.) I will treat all individuals with respect. This means that I will not yell at officials, coaches, players, spectators, or any other individual involved in the program. I know that conflict of any kind will not be tolerated.
- 2.) I will not ridicule, insult, or criticize anyone involved in the program.
- 3.) I will use appropriate language while at the program at all times and understand that cursing in any manner will not be tolerated.
- 4.) I will not blame anyone for decisions or results that do not go my team's way.
- 5.) I will encourage good sportsmanship in all activities and teach my child to lose with dignity and win with grace.
- 6.) Violations may result in penalties, ejections or suspensions from the program.
